

***FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTION OF SCHOOL LEVEL SCIENCE FAIR
& HOME-BASED SCIENCE FAIR 2022***

1. Which one we need to conduct School Level Science Fair or Home-based Science Fair?
The schools can choose to conduct School Level or Home-Based Science Fair according to their own preference. Take into consideration on the most suitable method for the implementation in your respective school.
2. How many questions/ activities the students need to do?
It's up to the teachers, or the "Panitia Sains" can decide on the number of questions for each standard.
3. How about the Marking?
Judging and marking will not be done by science fair team. The marking must be made by students' teacher.
4. How about the answers for the activities in the Science Experiments Book?
We have created a Teacher's Guide Book and it's provided upon request only. Please fill in the google form <https://forms.gle/t4bp5cbCjgjGg6J29> if you would like to have a copy of the Teacher's Guide Book. We will email it to you.
5. Do all the participating students will get medals?
No, medals will be only given to the winners. Number of medals for each school will be given according to the number of participations.
6. Do all the participating students will get the certificates?
Yes, all the participating students are eligible to receive participation certificate but Science Fair team will send only one (1) E-Certificate with the respective school's name in that. Teachers are advised to insert students name and give to the student as PDF copy or hard copy.
7. Can the school print the certificate and past it to the students?
Yes, you may print the certificate with student's name if you able to do so, otherwise you can just past the E-Certificate in pdf format to the students.
8. When to submit the proposal?
Proposal must be submitted 2 weeks before the actual School Level or Home-Based Science Fair date.
9. When to submit the Report?
Report must be submitted within 2 weeks upon completion of the competition.

10. When we will get the Medals?

Medals will be sent to your school according to the 3 posting date upon receiving your proposal. The posting dates as below:

- 1st posting date: 25 May 2022
- 2nd posting date: 30 August 2022
- 3rd posting date: 17 October 2022

11. Deadline to submit proposal, in order to get medals according to the posting dates?

- Deadline to submit proposal for 1st posting date: 11 May 2022
- Deadline to submit proposal for 2nd posting date: 18 August 2022
- Deadline to submit proposal for 3rd posting date: 3 October 2022

12. When we will get the E-Certificate?

E-certificate will be sent to the teachers email on the end of the Month.

13. What if we need the medals in between of the posting date?

The schools need to do their own arrangements for collection at Science Fair Secretariat office in Sea Park, Petaling Jaya.
